

JOIN THE "EUROPEANS FOR FAIR TRADE" TEAM

Our school has already joined the community of **Fair Trade schools** in 2014 as the first public school in Poland. For years 2016-2018 we received a grant for the project EUROPEANS FOR FAIR TRADE which is focused on the idea of ACTIVE CITIZENSHIP. The main aim of the project is to increase awareness of how Europeans can make a difference in order to combat discrimination and poverty, as well as to make participants understand the issue of equity with a particular focus on Fair Trade practices contributing to it.

The project encompasses four European secondary schools from Poland (it's us:), Scotland, Sweden and Spain. Each school is going to organize international project meetings which are going to last for 5 days (+ 2 days for travel) on the following topics: Fair Trade and Philosophy (Scotland), Fair Trade and Business (Sweden), Fair Trade and Economics (Spain) and Fair Trade and Sustainable Development (II LO, Poznań).

The project is created for II LO students from classes 2a, 2b, 2c, 2d, 2e and 2f. The teachers responsible are: prof. Elżbieta Koralewska, prof. Małgorzata Łuszczek-Pawełczak, prof. Anna Labrzycka and prof. Marcin Cieniuch.

18 students are going to be chosen for 3 project meetings abroad: 6 for each partner school meeting. We also need students who are going to help us organize the meeting in Poland. The participating students should be **ready for taking part** in the activities promoting the idea of Fair Trade in our school/community.

What to do to take part in the project?

STEP 1. Prepare a <u>presentation</u> (in English/ Power Point/Prezi) on the chosen topic connected with the Fair Trade issue (a detailed analysis of one narrow issue preferable/ max. 25 slides) and send it to: <u>autonomiaek@op.pl</u>. You can use the information/topics from FT webpages/popular magazines. Deadline: 30.09.2016.

At the end of your presentation present your idea: how to promote Fair Trade in our school. Add cost information if necessary.

Assessment criteria:

1. choice of an interesting FT topic	1 mark
2. depth	2 marks
3. good structure of the presentation	2 marks
4. creativity	2 marks
5. language	2 marks
6. layout	1 mark
TOTAL	10 MARKS

STEP 2. The authors of the best presentations will be invited for an <u>interview</u> (in English). The best candidates are going to be chosen for the project. Marks can be achieved for:

1. language (vocabulary and grammar)	4 marks
2. clarity	2 marks
3. power of persuasion	2 marks
4. fluency	2 marks
