

**ADMISSIONS REGULATIONS FOR THE IB (INTERNATIONAL BACCALAUREATE) CLASS IN II LICEUM  
OGÓLNOKSZTAŁCĄCE IM. GENERAŁOWEJ ZAMOYSKIEJ I HELENY MODRZEJEWSKIEJ IN POZNAŃ**

**2019/2020**

1. Students of the first class of the three year Polish high school, four year technical school and an equivalent class in another country are eligible for the recruitment process for the IB class.
2. Each candidate for the IB class is required to undergo a recruitment process that consists of aptitude tests in selected subjects.
3. Candidates for the IB class submit an application form for the aptitude test and a declaration of the selected IB subjects between 13-31.05.2019 in the IB office at the school premises. The application form is available as an attachment to the admissions regulations at [www.2lo.poznan.pl](http://www.2lo.poznan.pl) and in the IB office at the school premises.
4. Recruitment will be held on 10-11.06.2019. No other dates will be made available.
5. There is a fee for the aptitude tests. The fee is 120,00 zł and it is non-refundable. Fee exemption may be requested for candidates in difficult financial situations.

6. Candidates, students of the first class of the upper-secondary school in the Polish educational system, take aptitude tests in:
  - English
  - Mathematics (according to point 8 of admissions regulations)
  - other subjects from groups III and IV which they have chosen to study at Higher Level.Candidates who are not Polish citizens, and candidates who are Polish citizens but have received education in schools belonging to educational systems of other countries take aptitude tests in:
  - English
  - Polish
  - Mathematics (according to point 8 of admissions regulations)
  - subjects from groups III and IV which they have chosen to study at Higher Level.
7. The linguistic competences test is conducted in English and comprises a written and an oral part. The written part lasts 60 minutes and tests grammar, vocabulary and text analysis. The oral part lasts 10 minutes and tests linguistic competences, discussion skills, reasoning, defending one's point of view and providing arguments to support one's point of view. The level of the test is Advanced.
8. Only candidates who have chosen Mathematics Analysis & Approaches Course Higher Level or Standard Level are required to take the aptitude test in Mathematics. Candidates who have chosen Mathematics Applications & Interpretation Course Standard Level are not required to take the test. The test lasts 60 minutes and is conducted in Polish.
9. Aptitude tests in other selected Higher Level IB subjects (Group III: History, Geography; Group IV: Chemistry, Biology, Physics, Computer Science) last 60 minutes. The tests are conducted in Polish.
10. The aptitude test in Polish is conducted only for candidates who are not Polish citizens, and candidates who are Polish citizens that have received education in schools belonging to educational systems of other countries. The test lasts 60 minutes.

11. Total scores for the aptitude tests are as follows:

- English – 100 points
- Polish – 100 points
- Mathematics – 100 points
- Group III subjects – 50 points
- Group IV subjects – 50 points.

12. Candidates who receive a minimum 60% score from all aptitude tests combined will be accepted to the IB class.

13. Results of the aptitude tests along with the acceptance or rejection decision will be sent to the candidate's email address by 18.06.2019.

14. The candidate and his/her parents/legal guardians are obligated to familiarise themselves with the admissions regulations before they begin the recruitment process. Anyone interested in applying to the IB class may receive the admissions regulations at the school premises, or download the document from the school's website [www.2lo.poznan.pl](http://www.2lo.poznan.pl) in the section IB recruitment (rekrutacja IB).
